Muirbeck Specimen Lake Rules

- Pre booking of pegs via Fishery office 01461 700386
- Pegs are to be nominated at time of booking
- There are a total of 20 pegs on the lake. Visit the website for more information
- Full payment required at time of booking
- 24 hour tickets cost £25 fishing from 10am until 10am the following day, this is regardless of what time you arrive. You must leave by10am unless you have purchased another 24hr/day ticket
- Day tickets cost £15 and will be required to extend your 24 hour ticket past the 10am leaving time. Example purchase a 24hr ticket for a Saturday, start fishing at 10am, finishing at 10am on the Sunday. The day ticket allows you to extend your stay until closing time on the Sunday.
- No Children under 16, 16-18 years old's must be accompanied by an adult that is a competent angler
- Fishing from permanent pegs only no stalking permitted
- Maximum of 2 rods to be used at any time. However you can have others set up
- No rods to be left unattended whilst in the water
- No surface fishing or floating baits to be used. Pop ups and zig rigs are permitted
- Landing nets minimum 36 inches
- Beanie mats or unhooking cradles required
- Maximum size 6 barbless hooks
- Minimum 10lb mainline
- You can only fish halfway to the next peg occupied or not
- Fish are to be kept in the water to enable you to set up cameras and weighing equipment. Once you have weighed and photographed the fish it is to be returned to the water
- Damaged fish are to be reported to the fishery owners or bailiffs
- Weighing slings are required for weighing fish. If you do not intend to weigh your fish then it is to be returned to the water immediately
- No fish are to be transferred between lakes
- No braided mainlines except on spod/marker reels
- Only pre prepared particles are to be used
- Fires are not permitted, bivvy heaters are allowed
- Toilets are provided and are to be used. Anyone caught disobeying this rule will be charged a £50 clean up charge and asked to leave immediately without refund
- There is a toilet waste point located on the campsite for anyone using a cassette toilet in their bivvy (ask in tackle shop for details)
- All rubbish is to be bagged at all times and taken home with you. Anyone disobeying this rule will be charged a £50 clean up charge.
- The owners accept no responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or property whilst at the fishery
- Respect other anglers and visitors to the site
- Leave enough space for other anglers to get past
- Anglers are asked to report anyone in breach of the rules to the fishery owners or bailiffs

You maybe asked by a fishery bailiff to reel in your rods for inspection, your vehicle may also be required to be inspected
